Share Safely and Securely

- Review privacy settings on all of your social media platforms.
- Limit who can see your posts and personal information.
- Avoiding sharing location details in real-time.
- Be cautious with friend requests from unknown individuals.
- Avoid sharing ALL sensitive information (e.g. address, phone number)
- Use strong, unique passwords for each of your accounts.
- Always enable 2FA (two factor authentication) where possible.
- Review and remove old posts and information that is sensitive.
- Beware of clicking on suspicious links in messages or posts. Be aware, this means posts, direct messages, replies and more.
- Report and block suspicious accounts and messages.
