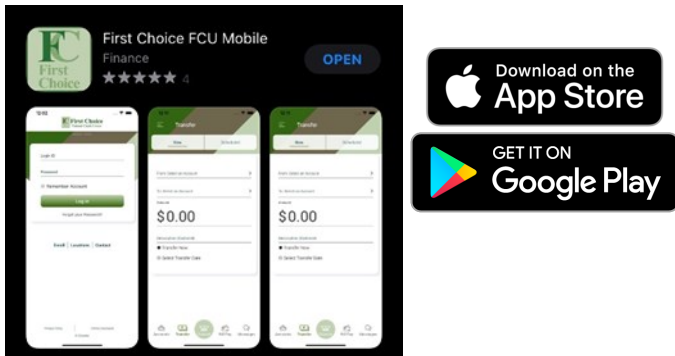
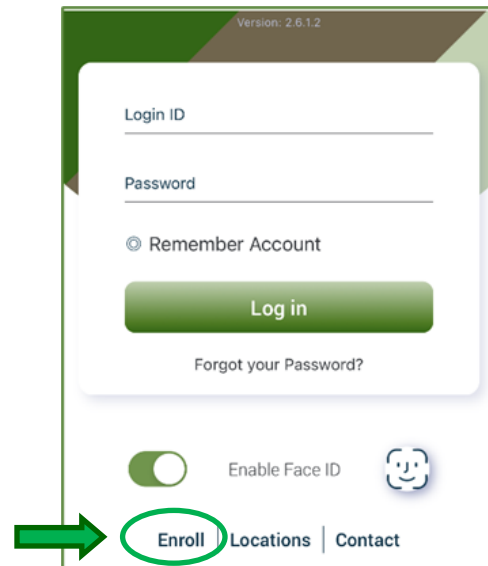


1. FIND OUR APP IN THE APPLE STORE OR ON GOOGLE PLAY

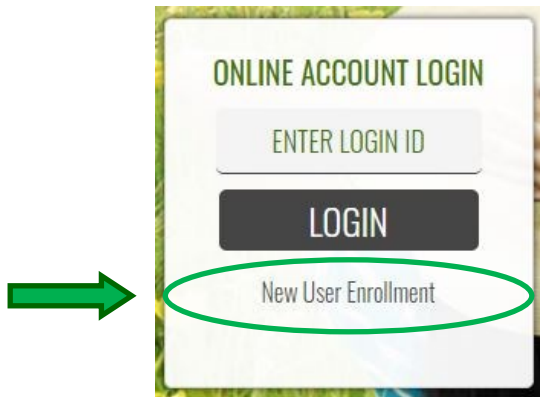
You can always choose to enable Face ID, if you do not want to enter your Credentials each time.
